



To Begin

Place the sharpening stone on your fingertips with the Gleason Guide™ on top, and rest your thumb gently on the guide to hold it in place.

- Use the fine white Diamond Head Ceramic Sharpening Stone™ to maintain sharp edges.
- To reshape or recreate the bevel, use the brown Transformation Sharpening Stone™.

Select either the Gracey or Universal/Sickle side, depending on your chosen instrument.

Place the back of the blade against the junction where the inside of the guide and the stone meet, called the "stop".

Maintain the "stop" position while dropping the terminal shank down to rest on the angled bar of the guide. This is called the "rest" position.

While maintaining the "rest" position with very light pressure, move the instrument back and forth in a pendulum (gliding) motion along the guide. If sharpening a sickle, skip step 4.

To shape the "Toe" of the instrument, pivot the heel on the beveled end on the Gleason Guide™. Rotate the handle of the instrument so that the curvature of the toe moves in an arc against the stone.

Bonus



The Ultimate Edge Kit™ also comes with a PingRing™. If your instrument has been correctly sharpened, its cutting edge should "ping" or grab the ring when it's sharp.
